SUMMARY The objective of this workshop is to support young information systems faculty members and less young PhD supervisors from France and all over Europe in their effort to publish their research in the most prestigious outlets within the information systems discipline. Over a period of three days, experienced editors or past-editors of leading information systems journals will work together with the participants in an interactive way to provide hands-on advice on the research publication process.

Topics of discussion include how to submit a paper to a top journal, manage the review process and respond to reviewers; how to build up a successful research team; how to position a manuscript and clearly define its contribution to theory; how to do a critical review of the literature and write a type of literature review; and how to get publication, based on qualitative or quantitative empirical research, in leading American and European journals. Beyond learning the craft (Kane & Tarafdar, 2026), how to leverage generative AI in various activities of each paper genre will be a key distinctive element from previous editions (ibidem), addressed by all presenters.

The seminar will be limited to 15 participants to foster a high level of interaction between participants and presenters (editors), as well as among participants. It will take place in Paris from December 9 to 11, 2026.
